C.O.P.E. Family Support Center recognizes the importance of the father's role in their child's life. Based on research, evidence shows that father involvement emerges in the context of a system of relationships. Each group meeting will emphasize central aspects of family life to target several risk and protective factors and to encourage fathers' active involvement in their children's lives.

- Develop strategies for coping with stress in your work and personal life.
- Learn proven co-parenting and conflict resolution skills.
- Develop greater self-confidence and beat depression and anxiety.
- Improve parenting confidence by learning parenting techniques for all ages and stages from toddlers to teenagers.
- Change generational patterns of difficult parentchild relationships to create a positive family life for you and your children.
